SHIFT OF GEAR: Since we are getting back into a more normal rhythm in parish life, I have decided to tweak things a little in order to balance things out a little, for you and for me. *Hence, from the 1st October*, and barring clashes with other events or commitments which may arise:

- 1) There will be <u>Agape</u> on the first Thursday of the month only. I encourage you to celebrate some form of Agape at home on a Thursday evening, remembering the events of the Last Supper with great love and devotion.
- 2) There will be a 10am Mass in Millport on the second Thursday of the month only, preceded by silent Exposition from 9am. There will be no Mass in Largs on that Thursday, but there will be Exposition at the side-altar with the Church's Morning Prayer from 10-10.30am.
- 3) There will be a <u>Service of the Word</u> on the third Sunday of the month only, in Largs.

- 4) There will be <u>Rosary and Benediction</u> on the second Sunday of the month only, in Largs.
- 5) There will no longer be a Friday evening Mass in Largs, both due to numbers in attendance and also to avoid the need for me to celebrate two Masses if there is a funeral on a Friday morning. We will therefore <u>return to a 10am Mass</u> on Fridays in Largs.
- 6) Except for emergencies, confessions will be heard before the Saturday Vigil Mass, from 5-5.45pm, using the small meeting room in the hall. There will also be confessions after the 10am Mass on Mondays in Largs, and after the 10am Mass on the Thursday I am in Millport. Anyone who wishes to queue for confession in Largs is invited to sit in the hall on the seats set out by the kitchen wall. Confessions will only resume in the Reconciliation Chapel once government and diocesan advice permit it and only after the damp problem we currently have in the confessional is fixed.
- 7) It is my intention to <u>re-open our churches</u> during the day for private prayer beginning on Sunday, 10<sup>th</sup> October. I will confirm or otherwise this decision nearer the time.

Having said all of the above, please never hesitate to get in touch with me if you need to speak with me. It is always better to phone or email and make an appointment. I am here to serve your spiritual needs as best I can!

ALL GROUPS USING THE HALL (Largs): Every Group, both parish and non-parish, must appoint a Track and Trace person to record the names and contact details of those attending their activity. This list can be developed into a checklist since mainly the same people attend each event. The checklist should be posted through the letter box at the Parish House after each session for our Parish Secretary to keep securely on file since the government requires that they must be kept for 21days. After that period, the lists will be destroyed.
