**LITURGY THIS WEEK:** In the midst of our dark and seemingly darker autumn (winter only starts on 21<sup>st</sup> December!), the Liturgy offers the light of Santa Lucia, whose very name means light. Hers is the light of witness to Christ in fidelity to her virginity and to her faith in Him. Fast forward 12 centuries and another light shines strongly through St. John of the Cross, a mystic and profound teacher of spiritual truth, persecuted along with St. Teresa of Avila for their combined attempts to renew the Carmelite order.

The remaining days of the week are ordinary Advent time, giving us the chance to ponder on the deep mysteries of Christ’s second coming and of his first. Friday 17<sup>th</sup> marks the first day of the Novena in preparation for Christmas. I will put the Novena prayer for each day up on the website. **SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:** 1) Largs Parish Hall. Saturdays, 5-5.45pm & Monday after 10am Mass. 2) Millport, after 10am Mass on second Thursdays. In an emergency, don’t hesitate to call Fr. Peter.

**PENANCE SERVICES (St. Mary’s):** On **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> December at 2pm**, we will have the first of two Penance Services, with four priests present to hear confessions. This afternoon service is intended for those who cannot come out in the dark and also for parishioners in Millport who may want to come.

On Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> December at 7pm, there will be a second Penance Service with four priests in attendance.

I encourage everyone who is able to come and receive the ineffable grace of absolution. It is nothing less than the power of the Spirit breathed forth by the Crucified and Risen Lord directly upon our souls to cleanse them and give them new life, to reconcile them to the life of God.

**NO SUNDAY DEVOTIONS (St. Mary’s):** This Sunday is second Sunday, 12<sup>th</sup> December, but there will be no evening devotions as I have to go to Paisley for the reception of the body of Bishop John Cunningham into the Cathedral at 6pm. If anyone wishes to attend Bishop Cunningham’s funeral, it is on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> December at 1pm at St. Mirin’s Cathedral, Paisley, Cathedral Precincts, Ince St, Paisley PA1 1HR. I am unable to attend due to the funeral of Mr. Edoardo Gatti, at the Crematorium late that morning.

**CAROL SERVICE (St. Mary’s):** As well as the half-hour carol service prior to the Christmas Eve vigil Mass, we will hold another one on **Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> December at 7pm**, followed by tea and mincemeat pies in the hall! ### **Synod Topic Five - Sharing Responsibility For Our**

**Common Mission:** Every baptised person is called to use their natural and supernatural gifts and talents to participate in the life and missionary service of the Church.

*Do we understand what this means? What stops us from giving our gifts and talents to the Church? How does the Church community support its members who serve society in various ways (social and political involvement, scientific research, education, promoting social justice, protecting human rights, caring for the environment, etc.)?* Fr. Stephen Latham has created a short video reflection, which is available on the diocesan webpage

We have to remember that the Synod is a work of the Holy Spirit and he can work better with those who open their hearts and minds to him in prayer.
