LITURGY THIS WEEK: Well do I remember being in St. Peter's Square in Rome when Pope St. John Paul II was elected on 16th October 1978. The first non-Italian in five centuries, he was to prove to be one of the greats in recent times. "Do not be afraid" was the rallying cry he gave to the Church and the world because he himself was fearless in the cause of Christ. We remember him on Wednesday. For the rest of the week, we revisit again some of the favourite devotions and truths of our faith: the Motherhood of Mary, the Holy Eucharist, the Sacred Heart and, this year, the Jubilee theme of pilgrims into hope.

SYNODAL CONSULTATION ON THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION: Thank you to everyone who organized and participated in the conversations in the Spirit, in both parishes, which Bishop Frank asked us to hold in relation to the Sacrament of Confirmation. Feedback has been very positive, although it does take time to get used to this way/method of working. The third conversation, which will discuss the question of the age at which the Sacrament should be administered, will take place on Sunday 9th November, after the 12.15pm Mass in Millport, and at 5pm in St. Mary's hall. I especially encourage young parents in the parish to get involved in this one, but everyone is, as always, most welcome. A sign-up sheet will be made available on the last Sunday of October.

SIGNS OF HOPE: The theme for the month of October is taken from the document which the late Pope Francis called, "Hope does not disappoint", written in preparation for this Jubilee Year. The theme is the need of signs of hope for the billions of poor on our planet. You will find the leaflet corresponding to this theme in the church porch. After quoting the words of Pope Francis, the leaflet offers some reflections. It then gives some short Scripture quotes regarding God's care for the poor followed by a short bio of saints who spent themselves for the poor. Some words of Pope St. John XXIII on the poor are then given. The leaflet concludes with a prayer.
